Participant will need:

- Baseball pants (color to be determined)
- Glove
- Baseball cleats Protective athletic supporter

Participation fee covers team shirt, hat, bats, helmets, catcher's gear, player insurance, participation medals, park and field maintenance (parking lots, mowing, restrooms, bleachers, insurance, trash collection, etc.)

Children are traditionally divided into 4 divisions (age as of February 3, 2015):

- Tee-ball (co-ed) – ages 5 & 6
- Minor (boys) – ages 9 & 10
- Coach pitch (co-ed) – ages 7 & 8
- Major (boys) – ages 11 & 12

JYAA is a non-profit, volunteer based organization. Volunteers are needed to perform numerous functions that serve to make JYAA successful. These include working the concession stand, organizing the concession stand operations, maintaining the fields, coaching, and being a team parent. Please know that when children are signed-up to participate in JYAA programs, families **MUST** volunteer their time in one or more of the above functions.

### **Your role as a parent/guardian:**

- Know the practice & game schedules and always have your child there on time
- Communicate with the coach on all planned or unplanned absences; teams are kept small so as to give children more of a chance to play; but with these smaller teams every player needs to show up at every game so the team does not have to forfeit
- Work a shift in the concession stand
- Serve as a role model by showing good sportsmanship
- Do not argue with the game officials
- Remember that the coaches are **VOLUNTEERS** who usually work full-time jobs and are giving their time so that your child can participate in this sport
