Participant will need:

Baseball/Softball Glove (Check with coach for correct size)

Softball pants or shorts & Socks (to be determined by the coach)

Participation fee covers team shirt, visor, use of ASA approved softball bats-helmets with face masks-practice and game balls, player insurance, umpire, league, & tournament fees, park maintenance (parking lots, mowing, restrooms, bleachers, insurance, trash service, etc.)

Children are traditionally divided into 4 divisions (age as of January 1, 2013):

8U – 7 & 8 year olds

12U – 11 & 12 year olds

10U – 9 & 10 year olds

14U – 13 & 14 year olds

- Serve as a role model by showing good sportsmanship
- Do not argue with the game officials
- Remember that the coaches are **VOLUNTEERS** who usually work full-time jobs and are giving their time so that your child can participate in this sport
